

The 1,500 small walleyes stocked last fall will be easily caught. Please handle them gently and return them to the water as quickly as possible, they have work to do in reducing our small panfish population!

Our goal is to establish a healthy predator-prey balance in the lake, which will improve fishing quality and lead to larger fish. To achieve this, we rely on stocking efforts and harvest limits. You can contribute to these efforts by sticking to these limits:

Cinnamon Lake 2025 Fish Limits



Largemouth Bass - 3 per day with only 1 over 15 inches



Smallmouth Bass -Catch and Release



Walleye -Catch and Release








Panfish - Yellow Perch, Crappie, Sunfish (all varieties) - no limit











Catfish - Channel and Bullhead please do not return the fish to the lake

Fishing Notes: Consider releasing lightly hooked desirable species if they are "Trophy" size. Let another angler enjoy them too! Cinnamon Lake fishing is open to members and their guests. <u>Guests must be accompanied by a responsible member at all times while fishing.</u> Use of live bait is permitted but please **DO NOT** dump unused minnows or empty minnow bucket water into the lake.
