Greetings to the members of Cinnamon Lake. January has been a bitter cold and snowy month but that is not all bad. The cold will help to reduce the number of insects we will see this coming summer and the snow will help to replenish the lake after the drought we experienced last fall. Thank you to our Treasurer Eric Hamman for all the hard work he put into preparing the 2025 budget.

In case you missed the January Coffee and Conversation meeting, the property at the front of Cinnamon Lake where the restaurant and shops are located has submitted a permit to construct a cell phone tower. A representative from the company contracted by Verizon to find a site for the tower was present and answered questions from our members. The board of directors will be discussing the tower during our next workshop.

Please remember to be aware of what you are putting into the compactor. Large items and construction material should be discarded in the open top dumpster located behind the office in the maintenance area. Those items jam the compactor and it is costly to repair the compactor. Contact the office to make arrangements to use the open top dumpster for large items. We also have recycle bins provided by the Ashland County Solid Waste district located down by the old water plant near the campgrounds. Cardboard, plastic and glass can be placed in those bins and there is no cost to Cinnamon Lake to haul those items away. We do have a contract to replace the old compactor but it has been delayed because we need to make improvements to the concrete pad where the compactor is located.

**Fish & Lake:** In 2025 the Fish and Lake Committee will be looking to expand on projects and plans initiated in 2024 including additional fish stocking, lake habitat improvement, water testing and quality control, algae bloom control, and muck and sediment reduction and control. It's a great time to get involved! Meetings are the last Tuesday of the month, January though November. Don't forget our Spaghetti Dinner and Silent Auction on Saturday February 8! Generous donors have provided some great auction items, with more to come! You can support our Cinnamon Lake improvement efforts, enjoy a great dinner for the cost of a donation, and perhaps score a bargain all in the same evening!
