NEW GATE SYSTEM: The new gate sticker system will be switched over on **Monday, March 10, 2025.** Your current gate card (s) will no longer work. Please make sure you have your new RFID sticker (s) on your vehicle (s) or a card. (only 2 cards per member account) The new kiosk will also be installed. Your guests will have to know your Cinnamon Lake address numbers. They must enter your four-digit Cinnamon Lake address numbers followed by your current four-digit Kiosk directory code. This new kiosk code will be eight digits long. The Kiosk will no longer call your home. Thank you all for your patience as we work to get the new system up and running. And for your continued patience. As with all new things there may be "bugs" that need to be worked out. We are trying to make this transition as smooth as possible for all members.

Greetings members: Another cold winter month is in our rearview mirror. February gave us sub zero temperatures in Ohio and record snow falls in Florida, but soon we will be fishing and swimming and enjoying the summer activities and events at Cinnamon Lake. Based on the legal advice from our attorney, the board has approved the permit for the cell tower. Currently, the tower company is considering several sites and may not choose the site by the Shops at Cinnamon Lake. It could take up to a year before they make their final decision. Fish & Lake: Many thanks to those that braved the ice to support our Spaghetti Dinner / Silent Auction. Big thanks to the silent auction item donors. This is one of our bigger fund raisers and we appreciate the community's support. We are gearing up for lake season and are planning for continued water testing, algae control and finishing up the reef project that we started in the fall. Another timely topic is goose control. ODNR informed us that now is the time to start hassling the geese so that they move on and do not nest here. So, hassle early and often. For geese that stay, we will be adding nests again this year in our continued efforts to control the population. Given the instances of bird flu this will be even more important this year. We appreciate the community's support and cooperation in our efforts. Note that feeding the geese is counterproductive, so we ask that you do not feed the geese. Since a single goose can produce up to 2 pounds of feces per day and bird flu is transmitted via feces, the fewer the geese the better in keeping our community safe.

Reminder Dates: Date of Record for voting in the June Annual meeting is **May 13, 2025, 4pm.** All balances must be paid current in order to be eligible to vote. Board of Directors applications must be turned in by **May 2, 2025, 4pm.** Annual meeting is **June 8, 2025, 2pm, Lodge.** There will be 3 open seats on the Association Board and 3 open seats on the Utilities Board.
