Project status: Road work will start up again in the spring. Questions about the road work should be directed to info@cinnamon-lake.com. Leave your question along with your name and contact info, our road project manager or a Board member will get back with you. There is also a tab on the Cinnamon Lake website with info about road work. Work on Pavilion 1 is expected to be completed by early summer barring any unforeseen circumstances. The goal is to make it a fun friendly place to gather. It will be available for rent as soon as the work is completed. Once road work is started up, the drive to and from the front gate will be re-vamped. Sometime in 2023 the gate card system will be replaced with an RFID system. Stay tuned for more information.

Friendly reminder: The speed limit in Cinnamon Lake is **25 miles per hour**. Over Christmas weekend, the Sheriff issued two traffic warnings, one of which was for speeding. Speeding tickets issued by the Sheriff's Department can mean large fines and points on your driver's license. They are helping us to monitor speeding. Please observe the posted limits. They are there to keep all users of the road safe.

News you can use: Trash collection prices have gone up in recent years. What's gone up as well is the trash tonnage the community generates. More tonnage means more costs to us. **We need your help.** Cardboard, paper, glass bottles and aluminum cans can all be recycled. Bagged aluminum cans can be dropped off at the Fish and Lake recycling bin (next to the trash compactor). Fish & Lake sells the cans and the proceeds go towards improving lake water quality. Cardboard can be recycled at the recycling bins by the old sewer plant across from the campground. Please recycle cardboard, glass bottles and paper. (Flatten your cardboard to make it less bulky when recycling.) By recycling cardboard we take its weight out of the trash compactor which helps keep our trash collection costs as low as possible.

Garden & Landscape: January 28th is the Early Order deadline for Garden and Landscape Committee's **Spring Flower Sale fundraiser**. By ordering early it will guarantee buyers will get the flower selection they want. Selling price is \$23 per basket. **Flowers can be picked up at the Lodge on May 13th from 9 to 11 am.** Proceeds from the flower sale go to the upkeep of the common areas.
