WATER'S EDGE AT CINNAMON LAKE APRIL, 2024

Don't forget: Application for CLA and CLU Board of Directors are due in the office by April 30th at 4pm. There are two seats open for each board. Date of record is May 14th-all balances must be paid in full to be eligible to vote at the June 9th Annual Meeting.

Help our Lake: Spring is here and soon the grass will be growing, getting fertilized, and in need of cutting. If you're on the lake, or near a waterway flowing into the lake, please maintain a 15-foot fertilizer free zone. Typical fertilizers contain nitrogen, essential for plant growth, but because it is water soluble it leaches into the waterways and into our lake. Phosphorous also contributes to plant growth, but it can deplete water oxygen and contributes to algae blooms. If you fertilize, choose an organic, slow nitrogen release type fertilizer, free of phosphorous. It is best to apply in the fall, as cool-season application helps strengthen grass roots. If you use a lawn service provider, talk to them about using these guidelines. Or ask them how best to keep fertilizer from entering the lake. When mowing, make the first few passes with the lawnmower blowing the grass into the lawn and not the lake. Blowing grass clippings, and leaves, into the lake results in sedimentation issues and water quality deterioration. It may not seem like a lot, but every little bit helps keep our lake healthy. Remember, it's the only lake we have.

Long Range Planning Survey: Thanks to all who completed the Long Range Survey. The feedback and written comments are appreciated by the Long Range Planning Committee. Lake dredging ranked the highest in relative importance to members followed by member communication, recreation areas, pool, docks, lodge replacement, basketball courts, campground, storage area and tennis courts. Written feedback ranged from concern over undertaking additional projects with the road loan still being paid for to "All of these items are assets to our community. The tough problem is finding the funds to be able to do them. The roads are a great start." The Long Range Planning Survey results will be the main topic of discussion at the next Coffee and Conversation on April 14th, in the Lodge at 2pm.
