Carp Derby 2023: They're off and angling. Fish & Lake's first Carp Derby is underway and runs through Labor Day weekend. The Derby is part of an effort to reduce the overpopulation of carp and improve the water quality and fish habitat in our Lake. For more information, email: fish-lake@cinnamnon-lake.com. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the Derby. As of July 23, almost 800 pounds of carp have been caught.

Did you know: The Polk-Jackson-Perry Fire District uses Cinnamon Lake as a training base for its rescue boat. The Fire District provides Fire and EMS coverage to the Village of Polk, Jackson Township, as well as part of Perry Township. The approximate size of the coverage area is 47 square miles. Cinnamon Lake provides a unique challenge to the Fire District because of the lake. The Fire District bought and refurbished a boat just to be able to react to any situations that might arise on the lake. The boat also has sonar capabilities. The Fire District is working on creating an underwater map of our lake. Operating the boat, however, requires training. Occasionally you might see their red boat out in the lake with a crew practicing rescue techniques and acceleration. The boat is there in case we have an emergency and they are trained to react to those emergencies. Just as important, the boat is in the lake whenever we have cardboard boat races or any competition in the water in case there is an emergency.







