Did you know: One of the major reasons many chose to live in Cinnamon Lake is because of the quiet it offers. Members appreciate the serenity and natural setting of our community. Our CCRs prohibit "an annoyance or nuisance to any owner of another lot." Quiet hours are from 11pm to 7am to help prevent construction equipment and others from disturbing the peace and to minimize noise late at night. Curfews for children under 16 years of age are from 11pm to 6am, unless accompanied by an adult. Wonderful weather and extended daylight bring out the party spirits in many of us. Let's be mindful of our neighbors and the quiet hours. If celebrations become too exuberant, members are always free to call the Sheriff's Department.

From Neighborhood Watch: The weather is great. The roads call out for walking, bicycling or even skateboarding and roller blading. Please be careful of all those on the road. Drive slow because you may not know who's around the bend. If you walk late at night wear light colored clothing, or even a safety vest. Be safe.
