## WATER'S EDGE AT CINNAMON LAKE NOVEMBER 2023

Hats off and a great big thank you to: The whole team on the Events Committee for their hard work on the Trunk and Treat. A great turnout, a lot of pumpkin and face painting, wonderful costumes, an old-fashioned hay ride and weather that definitely was fall-like. A good time was had by everyone.

Just so you know: Fish & Lake received notification that the grant for which they had applied, in partnership with the Ashland Water and Soil Conservation District. was not chosen for funding. Fish & Lake sought the grant from H2Ohio, a part of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, to help with weir improvement, Also, tied with the weir improvement was a downstream, in other words below the dam, creation of a wetlands that would help filter water that feeds the Muskingam watershed. Improving the weirs would have benefitted not just Cinnamon Lake but the watershed that Cinnamon Lake feeds. Fish & Lake was encouraged to re-submit for the grant next year. Early feedback indicates that if the downstream wetlands area were larger, the application may have been ranked higher. Discussions are underway on how we can improve the weirs. Recently members of Fish & Lake met with a marine construction company to discuss options, and costs, of removing silt from the lake. Early in December a meeting is scheduled with a lake management company to investigate ways of improving water quality. The October 3rd water quality test again showed readings at or below the threshold for most critical items, except for total phosphorous, which is a result of farm fertilizer.

<u>Coffee and Conversation</u>: The next monthly Coffee and Conversation is November 12th in the Lodge at 2 pm. Meet and Greet the Cinnamon Lake Committees will follow at 3 pm. Come meet the different Cinnamon Lake committees and find one that you can volunteer on.
