Just so you know: Fish and Lake volunteers raise money to treat the lake for algae and to pay for a quarterly water testing program. This year the algaecide cost was in excess of \$10,000. The water quality testing costs about \$1,000 per quarter. The latest test results showed a low reading for eColi. The threshold for recreational water is 235, at which point an advisory is issued. At a greater than 1,000 reading beaches must be close. The reading at our beach was 8 and at the center of the lake 4. Microcystin, a type of cyanotoxin, can multiply and create harmful algal blooms. Readings under 8 are considered acceptable; all readings in Cinnamon Lake were less than 0.240. The challenge is phosphorous, which enters the lake as a result of farm run-off. An acceptable reading is anything less than 0.05. Readings in Cinnamon Lake ranged from 0.08 to 0.10. Water quality is the reason that Fish & Lake has been working with Ashland County Soil and Water Conservation to get an ODNR grant to help improve water quality here anc further downstream. Water quality test results are posted online and in the mail houses.

<u>Help the Lake</u>: Please do not rake leaves or grass into the lake. If you fertilize your lawn, try to keep the fertilizer about 4-5 feet from the shoreline.
