Did you know: In 2007, CLA monthly dues were \$6.25 (\$75.00 per year) and the minimum wage was \$5.85. Today, in 2023, CLA monthly dues are \$6.25 (\$75.00 per year) and minimum wage is \$10.10.

Just so you know: The heavy rains in late August caused the lake level to rise considerably. Cinnamon Lake cannot just release the water and let it flow downstream. We must follow Ohio Department of Natural Resources guidance on lake and dam management. If there is flooding downstream, any release of water contributes to making that flooding worse and opens us to liability issues. Nature must take its course for the lake to return to normal levels on its own. ODNR worries about Muddy Creek, the Muskingum watershed, and communities downstream.

Open Forum Discussion: Topics during the community discussion period after the last Board meeting included: putting more cameras up in Cinnamon Lake, funding for play equipment and disbursement of Recreation Committee funds, speeding and protecting children in play areas, cleaning up properties around member's homes (including Cinnamon lake-owned lots), checks and balances on the Board of Directors, new sign at the entrance of Cinnamon Lake, some members feel they didn't get the roads they voted on, Sangria cul-de-sac is smaller after paving, no response to emails to the Board, enforcing CCRs on neighbors, school bus routes, and the no gun signs in common areas.
